
Angels

Allah has created angels out of light and given them various duties to perform.

- They are not visible to us.
- They do not commit sin nor do they disobey Allah, they do what Allah has ordered them to do.

The four famous angels are:

1. Hadhrat Jibraeel (as)- brought Allah's books orders and messages to all the prophets.
2. Hadhrat Michaaeel (as)- In charge of food, rain, skies and winds.
3. Hadhrat Izraeel (as)- Angel of death.
4. Hadhrat Israfeel (as)- will blow the trumpet on the day of judgement.

From Quran and Hadith, we come to know that various other Angels are in charge of other duties.

Kiraaman –Kaatibeen - There are two Angels whom write all the good and bad deeds of a person from the beginning of life, until death. This will be presented to us in a book form on the Day of Judgment.

Guardian Angels - These are the angels whom stay with everyone protecting them from harm. They protect a person with the command of Allah.

Munkar & Nakeer - The angels who will question a person in the grave.

Angels of Baait Al- Ma'mur - Allah built a house beneath the Throne called Baait Al – Mu'mur. He said to the Angels: *"perform tawaf around this house and leave the throne"* thereupon, the angels perform tawaf round the house. Seventy thousand angels visit the house night and day and the same angel will never have the chance to return due to vast number of angels who wait to visit the house.

Angels who pray for the believers - The prophet (saw) explained: *"Any servant that prays for me an angel will pray for him"*. And the prophet (saw) explained that there is an angel who prays for those who supplicate for others in their absence. The duties of these angels is to say *"Ameen"* to the prayers and *"to you be the same"*.
