


## English:

Children will be reading book 'Ug Boy Genius of the Stone Age' during this half term in English. This prehistoric fiction book, will take the reader through the journey of a young dreamer named Ug, who has many questions. Ug asks a lot of 'why' and 'why not questions', this will help pupils to enquire further into characters' feelings and emotions. Children will be writing haiku poems, creating information booklets adventure narratives and letters.



## Science:

For Science children will be exploring plants. They will learn about the plant lifecycle and the function of a flower for reproduction. Children will also learn about and experiment with plants that would have been included in Stone Age diets.

**Reading:** Each week there will be lessons reading four double pages spread of the book. Children will find & retrieve answers from the text. We will develop our skill to infer characters, feelings, thoughts and actions. Children will search up meanings of words from each chapter which will help to build their vocabulary.



## Dear Parents and Carers, Welcome to year 3 Spring 2 topic web

### Common Flower Parts




## Mathematics:

Pupils will continue to follow the Math no Problem Scheme, which is the Singapore math mastery approach. Children will be learning about length. measurements.



### Length/Width/Height

- mm = millimeter
- cm = centimeter
- m = meter



- 10mm = 1cm
- 100cm = 1m
- 1000m = 1km

## History:

Children will research the Stone Age. They will learn about the lifestyle of people who were living in these era. They will research diet, jobs, accommodation and skills which includes making tools and shelters. This will lead pupils to understand the evolution of the human race.

P.E. is on Wednesday and Friday, children need to bring their full P.E. kits on both days.

#### Water:

We recommend that children bring a bottle of water with their names written on it, to school every day. This will be kept in the classroom and the children will have access to it throughout the day.

### *Home learning*

- Practice measuring and converting length at home. Remember that 10mm = 1cm, 100cm = 1m and 1000m = 1km.
- Research the lifestyle of people in the Stone Age and discuss the similarities and differences to our lifestyle today.
- Research prehistoric artefacts and how they were created.
- Explore when people started farming, and what crops were planted in the Stone Age.
- Research what is a geologist and what tasks they undertake within their role.

#### Reading:

It is a very important part of your child's learning. At school we will have reading sessions every day. We also encourage the children to read each day at home.
